DHFLA 75th Anniversary Gala

DHFLA hosted its 75th Anniversary Gala on Sunday October 10, 2010 at the Westin Park Central in Dallas. The event celebrated the association's 75th anniversary and honored long time board member and community civic leader Mike Friedman. Over three hundred guests, some from as far away as Australia, enjoyed a sit down V'aad Supervised kosher meal. The evening began with an open bar and a slide show featuring Mike and DHFLA founders (courtesy of JSF Computing).

Brendon Higgins, formerly of NBC Channel 5, was the Master of Ceremonies for the evening. After welcoming remarks by Mr. Higgins and DHFLA President Arthur Skibell, the national anthem was lead by Bennett Glazer, gold sponsor for the event and CEO of Glazer's Distributors. The Dallas Jewish War veterans conducted a flag ceremony and Ruth Schor led guests in singing hatikva. Rabbi David Stern of Temple Emanu-EL conducted the HaMotzi, Kiddush, and invocation.

International Association of Hebrew Free Loan President Richard Broder of Michigan made some remarks and Past DHFLA President Marvin Feldman introduced student loan recipient Eric Rosenbaum who spoke on how the student loan he received from DHFLA has made a difference for him and his family.

State Senator Florence Shapiro introduced the keynote speaker, Fred S. Zeidman, Chairman of the U.S. Holocaust Museum, Washington D.C. Mr. Zeidman spoke eloquently of how the motto of the US Holocaust Museum, "from memory to action; what you do matters" and "Gemillut Chesed (acts of loving kindness) are fused at their cores and are expressions of the same ideals.
